We welcome all performers of any experience level to audition. We aim to showcase the talents of individuals of all ages, races, genders, sexualities, nationalities, and capabilities throughout our seasons. However, some specific shows may have requirements regarding age, sex, and/or race, which is always disclosed in audition calls and during the auditioning/casting process.

Unless otherwise specifically stated, all roles are available to be cast during auditions. Due to our rotating production crews, sometimes audition requirements change slightly. Please read the audition packet per production thoroughly!

Directing professionally since 2015, Lauren S. AGE Notes:

This may limit the opportunities for teens to be cast.



Audition Needs

BEFORE YOUR AUDITION:

Make sure you finalize your audition form and schedule your audition time online. Auditions are by appointment only, in 30 minute slots. Auditions are in person only at this time. Auditions are closed; only those who are auditioning at the appointed time will be allowed in the house.

FOR YOUR AUDITION:

MUSIC: Please sing 16-32 bars of a song of your choice from a comparable Broadway musical. You can bring in a karaoke/backing track to play or sing acapella, if you choose.

DANCE: No dance call will be done during auditions. Dance calls will take place during callbacks, if needed.

SIDES: Please choose one of the short monologues provided on the next page to have memorized for your audition. You do not have to choose a side from the role you prefer.

AFTER YOUR AUDITION:

If callbacks are needed, you may be invited by the director to come back to dance, sing, and/or act for specific roles. Not receiving a callback does not mean you will not be cast, and vice-versa. All auditionees will be notified whether or not they were cast in the production with 48 hours of the callback. Reaching out to anyone within the production team before that allotted timeframe has passed will automatically revoke any possible offers. Auditions are not a guarantee of being cast in this production. The production team reserves the right to cast as they deem best for this production. If you are not cast, we encourage you to audition for a future show!

SEYMORE

Tomorrow morning ... right after Life Magazine takes our picture — you know who bites the dust! They'll snap the photo, we'll be famous, I'll take that TV job, and we'll live a nice, quiet, normal life together. No more night feedings. No more squalling for blood! ... (gently) There's nothing to be scared of. We'll go away from here. I'll take you to that little development you always dreamed about and once we're there we'll live happily ever after, I promise. Nice little house, nice little car ... (beat) And no plants. No plants at all.

CRYSTAL/CHIFFON/RONNETTE

There he is girls! I found him! There's Seymour! (exaggerated, with ulterior motive) Seymour! Can we have your autograph? We saw you on Channel Five News! You looked so handsome, and you gonna be so RICH! Is it true Audrey Two is the Grand Marshal for the Rose Bowl? Is it true the shop is decorating for the Senior Prom? (suddenly cooly, in control) There's another big hot shot lookin' for you, Seymour. From uptown. He's been askin' all over, where can he find you? You're famous Seymour.

MR. MUSHNIK

Look, God, what an existence I got! Misfit employees, bums on the sidewalk, business is lousy. My life is a living hell. You! Urchins! Off the stoop! It ain't bad enough I got the winos permanently decorating the storefront? I need three worthless ragamuffins to complete the picture? You ought to be in school. (Beat) Look at that! Six o'clock and we didn't sell so much as a fern. I guess this is it. Don't bother coming in tomorrow. What, what, what don't I mean? I mean I'm closed, forget it, kaput. Extinct! I'm closing this God and customer-forsaken place.

AUDREY

Oh no. It's just a daydream of mine. A little development I dream of. Just off the interstate. Not fancy like Levittown. Just a little street in a little suburb, far far from urban Skid Row. The sweetest, greenest place — where everybody has the same little lawn out front and the same little flagstone patio out back. And all the houses are so neat and pretty ... 'Cause they all look just alike. Oh, I dream about it all the time. Just me. And a toaster. And a sweet little guy. Like Seymour...

AUDREY II (THE PLANT)

I'll make it worth your while. You think this is all a coincidence, baby? The sudden success around here? Your adoption papers? If I can talk and I can move, who's to say I can't do anything I want? Like deliver, pal. Like see you get everything your secret, greasy heart desires. You didn't have nothin' til you met me. C'mon, kid, what'll it be? Money? Girls? One particular girl? How 'bout that Audrey? Think it over! There must be someone you could eighty-six real quiet-like and git me some lunch!

ORIN

Oh, of course. The guy with the plant. And the band-aids. And the gun. So why you pointing a gun at me, Seymour? Hey, Are you a little bit nervous about seeing a dentist? it's only gonna hurt a little. Say "Ah"! Oooh, your mouth is a mess, kid. You've got cavities, You've got plaque. You're impacted. You're abscessed! You need a complete oral examination. We'll start with that wisdom tooth! We'll just rip the little bugger out of there. Whatdyo say? Let's get started. This is gonna be a challenge. This is gonna be a pleasure. I'm gonna want some gas for this one. I want to really enjoy this and I find a little giggle gas before we begin increases my pleasure enormously. In fact... I'm gonna use my special gas mask! Just relax, Seymour, I'll be with you in a moment.

SUPPORTING LEADS

Chiffon, Crystal & Ronnette:

Female presenting. Sometimes presenting as the 'street urchins', sometimes the narrating Greek chorus, these three ladies are the only ones who - somehow - seem to have a grasp of reality. While not mandatory, these characters are typically and preferably performed by BIPOC actresses, ages 16+.

Vocal Range: F5-Ab3 (mezzo)

Mr. Mushnik:

Male presenting. The seasoned boss of the downtown flower shop on the Eastside, Mr. Mushnik is the embodiment of profits-driven and manipulative, which he often uses against his employee, Seymour. Strong New York accent preferred.

Age Range: 40s+

Vocal Range: F4-G2 (baritone/bass)

Dance Ability: Standard dance ability

Orin Scrivello:

Male presenting. Abusive, delusional, and highly charismatic, Orin is a dentist and Audrey's loser boyfriend. This character can be stand alone or play multiple roles, but should have physical and verbal comedic timing. **Will be cast 18+.**

Age Range: 20-40

Vocal Range: G4-G2 (baritone)

Male or female presenting. The voice and eventual personification of the alien, man-eating plant monster must command a presence with a sultry, jazzy voice. This performer must be comfortable performing in some form of 'drag' and may have some puppeting.

GRACE BRADLEY (reads ages 30-45)

Well, let me tell you...Helen Armstrong is not the only woman alive who can run a Christmas pageant! I made up my mind to just do the best I could under the circumstances, but now I'm going to make this the best Christmas pageant ever, and I'm going to do it with the Herdmans! After all, they raised their hands and nobody else did, and I don't care... *(to Father)*...And you're going to help me!

BETH BRADLEY (reads ages 12-17)

It did seem real, as if it might have happened just that way. We all thought the pageant was about Jesus, but that was only part of it. It was about a new baby, and his mother and father who were in a whole lot of trouble – no money, no place to go, no doctor, nobody they knew. And then, arriving from the East – like my uncle from New Jersey – some rich friends.

Because of the Herdmans, it was a whole new story – Imogene, burping the baby, and the Wise Men bringing such a sensible present. After all, they couldn't eat frankincense! And even Gladys – “He's in the barn. Go see him”...so the shepherds didn't have to stumble around all over the countryside. But I guess it wasn't like that for Imogene. For her, the Christmas pageant turned out to be all wonder and mystery, as if she just caught on to what Christmas was all about.

IMOGENE HERDMAN (reads ages 12-17)

My God! They didn't have room for Jesus? Didn't Mary know who he was? *(Pointing to Ralph who is playing Joseph)* Didn't he know? What was the matter with Joseph, that he didn't tell them? Her pregnant and everything...and you mean they tied him up and put him in a feedbox? Where was Child Welfare?

GLADYS HERDMAN (reads ages 7-10)

(As the Angel of the Lord appearing to the Shepherds in the Pageant; rough and without decorum) Hey!...Hey!... Unto you a child is born!...It's Jesus, and he's in a barn...Go see him! Go on, he's over there!

BOB BRADLEY (reads ages 30-45)

Well...that's what they were...Mary and Joseph. They were refugees, in a way. They were a long way from home, didn't have any place to stay, didn't know anybody. They were probably cold and hungry and tired...and messy. *(To Mother)* I think you worry too much. Now...I'm going to push baby angels onstage, and I'm going to hand out shepherd's crooks and then push them onstage...When do I do all that?

MRS. ARMSTRONG (reads ages 40+)

I'll tell you again, Grace, how important it is to give everyone a chance. Here's what I do – I always start with Mary and I tell them we must choose our Mary carefully because Mary was the mother of Jesus...Yes, and then I tell them about Joseph, that he was God's choice to be Jesus' father. That's how I explain that. Frankly, I don't ever spend much time on Joseph because it's always Elmer Hopkins, and he knows all about Mary and Joseph...but I do explain about the Wise Men and the shepherds and how important they are. And I tell them, there are no small parts, only small actors. Remind the angel choir not to stare at the audience, and don't let them wear earrings and things like that. And don't let them wear clunky shoes or high heels. I just hope you don't have too many baby angels, Grace, because they'll be your biggest problem

CHARLIE BRADLEY (reads ages 7-13)

(Singing) “Sweet hour of prayer, sweet hour of prayer, because there are no Herdmans there. And Jesus loves us, as they say, because he keeps them miles away.” I don't care what everybody else said, that's what they really thought. All that other stuff is okay but the main good stuff about church is that the Herdmans aren't there, ever... That's what I said...stay away from them. Go to church.

"The Cat in the Hat tells the story of Horton, an elephant who discovers a speck of dust that contains the Whos, including Jojo, a Who child sent off to military school for thinking too many "thinks." Horton faces a double challenge: not only must he protect the Whos from a world of naysayers and dangers, but he must guard an abandoned egg, left in his care by the irresponsible Mayzie La Bird. Although Horton faces ridicule, danger, kidnapping and a trial, the intrepid Gertrude McFuzz never loses faith in him. 

Berryman, the old goat: "the world is gradually becoming a place where I do not care to be anymore." I don't know what it says about me that I have a greater affinity with the damaged. probably nothing good. I admire the hell out of Eliot the poet, but the person? I can't identify.

VIOLET

I ever tell you the story of Raymond Qualls? Not much story to it.

Boy I had a crush on when I was thirteen or so. Real rough-looking boy, beat up Levis, messy hair. Terrible under-bite. But he had these beautiful cowboy boots, shiny chocolate leather. He was so proud of those boots, you could tell, the way he'd strut around, all arms and elbows, puffed up and cocksure. I decided I needed to get a girly pair of those same boots and I knew he'd ask me to go steady, convinced myself of it. He'd see me in those boots and say,

"Now there the gal for me." Found the boots in a window downtown and just went crazy: I'd stay up late in bed, rehearsing the conversation I was going to have with Raymond when he saw me in my boots. Must've asked Momma a hundred times if I could get those boots. "What do you want for Christmas, Vi?" "Momma, I'll give all of it up for those boots." Bargaining, you know? She started dropping hints about a package under the tree she had wrapped up, about the size of a boot box, real nice wrapping paper. "Now Vi, don't you cheat and look in there before Christmas morning." Little smile on her face. Christmas morning, I was up like a shot, boy under the tree, tearing open that box. There was a pair of boots, all right... men's work boots, holes in the toes, chewed up laces, caked in mud and dog poo. Lord, my Momma laughed for days. My Momma was a mean, nasty old woman. I suppose that's where I got it from.

JEAN

Mom and Dad don't mind. You won't get into trouble or anything. I say they don't mind. I just mean they don't mind that I smoke pot. Dad doesn't. Mom kind of does. She thinks it's bad for me. WARGRAVE

He puts a little dollop of something in her tea, then washes the cup and tells the doctor she hadn't had nothin'...! You'd be surprised, Miss Claythorne, what some husbands would do.

LOMBARD

All judges look like tortoises. They have a venomous way of darting their heads in and out. Mr. Justice Wargrave is no exception. Oh yes! He's probably been responsible for sending more innocent people to their deaths than anyone in England. A remarkably fine night!



QUASIMODO

(To his bells) Marie! You're in very good voice today! Jacqueline, we need to fix your clapper! Go on, Gabrielle! Pour your flood of sound into the square! It's a holiday! Sing! My bells, sing till you are all quite out of breath! Morning, my little birdies! I wish you could be like those birds and just fly away. To be out there. But no, probably too dangerous. This Cathedral is not only my home, but my universe. It is peopled with figures of marble... With kings and saints... Monsters and demons... The saints blessed me... And the monsters that protect me. Today is the Feast of Fools! Maybe I should try going down there. No, Master won't allow it. Last year, he said, "Someday... maybe." He always says "someday"—never "today"! (Frollo enters - Quasimodo's speaking becomes halted and awkward) M-m-morning M-m-master. Just talking to my f-friends... made of s-s-stone. Can w-we see the F-feast of F-f-fools, Master? N-nevermind... others w-would laugh at m-m-me.

ESMERALDA

Why do you hate us so much? What did we ever do to you?! I came here to find that boy. It was my fault he was up on the stage in the first place. He's no less human than the rest of us. I dance because I enjoy it. Others enjoy it, too, and give me money. If I had the power of magic, why wouldn't I use it to help myself and my people?! Your grace, there must be some charity inside you. If you've helped that boy, then surely you can extend that kindness to others almost as unfortunate. How you would wish others to treat you, could you not treat them?

CLAUDE FROLLO

So a gypsy dares to enter this holy place. Your kind aren't allowed here. What are you doing in here? The boy doesn't need your help. He's my charge. God loves even a monster. Some of us are less human. In the moral sense. You dance in public without shame or modesty. Do you also deny possessing black magic? You're clever. You twist the truth just as you twist your body and dance. Our Lord Jesus said something. You see him on the cross there, gazing down on us? Midnight mass is starting. I must go. My child, though your people are lost, maybe something within you can be saved. Stay. Perhaps you'll see what true beauty is and we...We can continue this conversation afterwards.

CHOIR NARRATOR
